Who are these services for?

Children and adolescents (age 3 years up to 18 years) experiencing emotional or behavioural concerns as well as symptoms of mental illness.

Parents, families or caregivers seeking consultation and support services.

One point of access:

In order to improve access to WRHA child and adolescent mental health resources, intake and referral services have been linked to create a single point of entry.

Centralized Intake is able to directly refer to services at MATC, St. Boniface General Hospital and Health Sciences Centre. The service can also assist the process of redirection to other appropriate agencies/programs.

Who can refer to Centralized Intake?

Parents, caregivers, doctors and/or counsellors can make referrals.

Self-referrals can also be made.

Centralized Intake always contacts the legal guardian when the client is under 16 years.
